Thursday, March 25th – C.A.S.U.A.L. Day, throughout NEPA

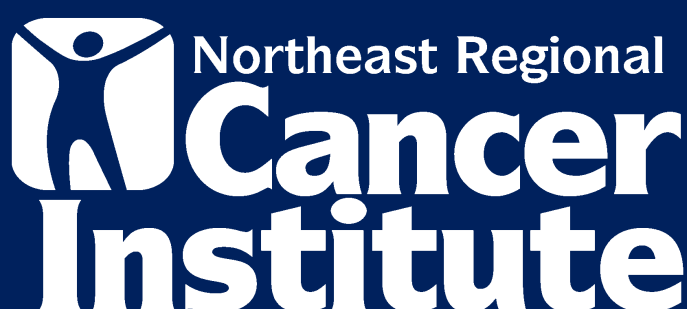
